

There have been a lot of "dystopian-future" novels written about how the US could collapse into an apocalyptic society of terror and turmoil as a result of a terrorist attack and subsequent breakdown of our power grid and infrastructure. I have read several of them. I personally found this particular book to be highly believable and realistic. When a small group of workers from southern Virginia attend a company convention in northern Virginia all hell breaks loose. This is the story of how they attempt to return home to their families over 250 miles away. Their efforts are fraught with peril and danger along the way. The situations they encounter seemed to me to be natural and acceptable, as well as the other people and situations they encounter along the way. A WORD OF CAUTION ... the author of this book seems to personally be politically conservative. That won't be a problem for most; but, reading through the reviews you will see that several individuals wrote negative reviews primarily because they appeared to have a problem with some of the right-leaning actions and decisions the protagonists were forced to make which

take place throughout the stories unfolding. Sad to say, but, if you personally are very liberal in your life perspective, you might want to skip this book and find one more supportive of your own ideology. (I make this claim not to be judgmental but to offer sincere advice.)

What is it about "Bug out" stories that have to have pages and pages of descriptions about guns? As many of these as I have read, I should be an expert by now, but my eyes roll up in the back of my head and I manage to skim past the descriptions - and lose track of who has what bullets or guns. I swear if the gun descriptions, including the descriptions of how many are cached away were removed from the books, the pages reduced - I'm guessing these would qualify as short stories. Having said that - this is a better than average post-apocalyptic novel. What I really liked about the book is that the author has a really good technical writing skill. He also did a great job describing how the apocalypse came about - and quite frankly, I wouldn't be a bit surprised if it were to happen that way. I've always thought the amount of money spent overseas is completely insane and borders on treason by our own government - if they were to put that much money into shoring up our own country - the scenarios described here should not ever happen - yet it probably could and will. It was really hard to like the characters of the story. But that's OK - it's what made the story grow well - they became either better people or worse people - depending on their true natures. This book only got better as it got to the end and I definitely wanted to move on to the second book.
