


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Mr. Global Leather has been murdered!

It's like a leather BONFIRE OF THE VANITIES, a comedy of manners dressed up as a whodunit. Antoniou has enormous affectionate fun with leather foibles and fashions and the goofy rhythms and practices of title contests, all the while managing to keep a cast of dozens busy in a half-dozen subplots and a couple of unlikely romances. The narrative just gets swifter and more interesting as it unfolds, along the way managing to give us food for thought about what "real" leather and "real" mastery is.

This book is damn funny.
